The following fees are applicable for the above Full-time programmes unless specified otherwise:

A. General Fees:

1. Degree and Diploma/degree: Rs 13,100 per annum
2. Diploma: Rs 12,350 per annum
3. Certificate/Foundation: Rs 10,800 per annum

B. Students' Fund: Rs 300 per annum

C. Tuition Fees:

Tuition fees are **not** applicable to Full-time programmes **except** the following:

1. **Foundation programme in Design** (1 yr F/T): Rs 1,200 per credit
2. **Diploma in Sanitary Science** (2 yrs F/T): Rs 1,200 per credit
3. **BSc (Hons)/MSc Chemistry** (3/4 yrs F/T): General and Tuition Fees for Postgraduate programmes shall apply in the 4th Year of the programme.
4. **BSc (Hons)/MSc Nutritional Sciences** (3/4 yrs F/T): General and Tuition Fees for Postgraduate programmes shall apply in the 4th Year of the programme.

D. Laboratory Fee:

A Laboratory Fee of Rs 4 350 per annum is applicable for all full-time **Science and Technology** programmes in which there are lab-based modules.

E. Other Fees:

1. For **BSc (Hons) Medical Science**, a Clinical Training Fee of Rs 6,000 per annum is applicable.

2. For **BSc (Hons) Occupational Therapy**, a Professional Placement Fee of Rs 12,000 per annum is applicable.
3. **'Auditeur Libre'**:
For applicants wishing to follow one module, or more, from the undergraduate programmes as **'Auditeur Libre'**, fees of Rs 1 200 per credit and an additional fee of Rs 750 for each lab-based module and any other relevant fees, are payable upon enrolment on the module/s.
4. **Final year students**, where applicable, will have to pay a Dissertation Fee of Rs 3 000. This Fee will be shared by students undertaking group dissertations.

B. Students' Fund: Rs 300 per annum

C. Tuition Fees:

Tuition fees of Rs 1,200 per credit are applicable to all the above Part-time programmes.

D. Laboratory Fee:

Where applicable, a Laboratory Fee of Rs 750 is applicable for each lab-based module.

E. Other Fees:

1. 'Auditeur Libre':

For applicants wishing to follow one module, or more, from the undergraduate programmes as 'Auditeur Libre', fees of Rs 1 200 per credit and an additional fee of Rs 750 for each lab-based module and any other relevant fees, are payable upon enrolment on the module/s.

2. **Final year students**, where applicable, will have to pay a Dissertation Fee of Rs 3 000. This Fee will be shared by students undertaking group dissertations.

2. **School-Leavers** who are ranked after the 2008 LAUREATES are eligible for Scholarship at the University upon registration as students of the University of Mauritius. The Scholarship cover the General Fees, but exclude Registration Fees and Students' Fund Fee (amounting to Rs 1,800). The Scholarship must be taken in the current Academic Year and may not be postponed.
 3. **Mature candidates** may apply for all the above programmes, **except** for the BSc (Hons) Medical Science and Bachelor of Laws with Honours - LLB (Hons). They must submit a letter applying for admission as mature candidate and submit documentary evidence of work experience together with their Application Form. Please refer to section 1.6 of the 'General Information to Students' handbook 2009/2010 for criteria of eligibility.
 4. Applications are also invited from suitably qualified candidates wishing to follow one module, or more, from the under-mentioned programmes as '**Auditeur Libre**' against payment of relevant fees.  5. Tuition fees are exclusive of general fees.

 7. **A discount of 5% on Tuition Fees** will be provided to students paying the whole amount of Tuition Fees for the academic year upon registration.

 - 100% of General Fees + 50% of Tuition Fees to be paid on registration date
 - Balance of 50% of Tuition Fees to be paid in 3 equal and consecutive monthly instalment
 - A bank standing order form will be available at the Budget Director's Office during the registration exercise. The form duly filled in, should be submitted before registration.

- In case of revocation of the bank standing order before its termination, the student will not be admitted to the examinations, as per University regulations.

 - (ii) A Bank Office Cheque or a Postal Money Order (drawn to the order of UNIVERSITY OF MAURITIUS) of Rs 1 000 representing a non-refundable Application Fee.
- ✚ Applicants will **not** be required to call at the University for application procedures.
- ✚ You are advised to keep the Mauritius Post Ltd postage receipt and a photocopy of the Bank Office Cheque/Postal Money Order as evidence of application.
- ✚ The University will acknowledge receipt of application online when all the above-mentioned documents are received. Applicants will then be able to print their receipt online.
- ✚ Limited computer facilities for Online Application will be available on the UoM campus. Applicants are strongly advised and encouraged to complete all application procedures from their home, so as to avoid long queues.

Photocopies of educational certificates and other supporting documents should be attached. Applicants will not be required to call at the University for application procedures.

Deadline for submission of application is Friday 06th March 2009.

- (i) Applications received after the closing date, or not supported by the relevant documents and/or Application Fee of Rs 1,000 will not be considered.
- (ii) Applications not submitted on the prescribed online form will not be considered.
