1. GENERAL

2. SUBMISSION OF APPLICATION

- (i) Applicants should submit a photocopy of their birth, educational and professional certificates with their application. Original certificates should **NOT** be submitted at the time of application but produced at Registration in case the applicant is selected. Please note that the photocopies of certificates submitted will not be returned.
- (ii) A non-refundable Special Application Fee of Rs 300 (Bank Office Cheque OR Postal Money Order in favour of University of Mauritius) will be charged upon submission of Application Form.
