

INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS WHO WISH TO STUDY FOR A SHORT PERIOD (ONE SEMESTER / ONE YEAR) OR CARRY OUT SHORT-TERM PROJECTS AT THE UNIVERSITY OF MAURITIUS

International students are required to submit the following documents:

- copies of their educational certificates and University transcripts (duly translated in English); and
- a recommendation letter from their University.
- Students not possessing a recognised qualification in English Language should provide evidence of proficiency in same, e.g. TOEFL (Test of English as a Foreign Language), IELTS (International English Language Testing System), or other similar tests.

International students from 12-year schooling systems may be required to sit for SAT (Scholastic Aptitude Test).

There is no need to fill an application form if students wish to spend one semester (or less) or two semesters at the University of Mauritius.

1. Students studying for one semester/one year

Students are advised to consult the University website (<http://www.uom.ac.mu>) to make their choice of modules and to submit same along with the above-mentioned documents to the University.

Upon receipt of all the documents, the choice of modules of the student is then referred to the Dean of Faculty concerned who decides whether the student can be admitted on the basis of her/his qualifications.

The student will then be informed of the Dean's decision via email/fax and in case of a positive reply, a letter of offer will be issued to the student, specifying the approved modules and the appropriate fees to be paid. All international students will be required to fill in the 'Application to enter Mauritius' form and submit same to the University.

2. Students undertaking short-term projects for one semester/year or part thereof

Students must submit the above-mentioned documents together with their project title/research interest to the University.

Upon receipt of all the documents, the student's request is then referred to the Dean of Faculty concerned who decides whether the student can be admitted on the basis of her/his qualifications. A supervisor will be allocated to the student.

The student will then be informed of the Dean's decision via email/fax and in case of a positive reply, a letter of offer will issued to the student, specifying the project title/duration and the appropriate fees to be paid. All international students will be required to fill in the 'Application to enter Mauritius' form and submit same to the University.

N.B. International students are not allowed to work in Mauritius.
