FEES FOR PART-TIME UNDERGRADUATE PROGRAMMES

THE UNIVERSITY RESERVES THE RIGHT TO REVIEW GENERAL FEES, TUITION FEES AND OTHER CHARGES FOR ANY GIVEN ACADEMIC YEAR PRIOR TO THE BEGINNING OF SUCH ACADEMIC YEAR.

The following fees are applicable for the above Part-Time programmes unless specified otherwise:

A. General Fees:

1. Degree: Rs 13,100 per annum
2. Diploma: Rs 12,350 per annum
3. Certificate: Rs 10,800 per annum
4. For Flexible and Open/Continuous Learning Programmes:

Semester basis	Yearly basis
For 1 – 3 modules – Rs 1 500 per semester	For up to 18 credits – Rs 3 000 per annum
For 4 – 6 modules – Rs 3 000 per semester	For more than 18 credits – Rs 6 000 per annum

B. Students' Welfare Fund: Rs 300 per annum

C. Tuition Fees:

Tuition fees of Rs 1,200 per credit are applicable to all the above Part-Time programmes.

D. Laboratory Fee:

Where applicable, a Laboratory Fee of Rs 750 is applicable for each lab-based module.

E. Other Fees:

Final year students, where applicable, will have to pay a Dissertation Fee of Rs 1 500. This Fee will be shared by students undertaking group dissertations.

(ii) TAUGHT POSTGRADUATE PROGRAMMES

Candidates who are in their final year and who will graduate by end July 2010 may be considered for a conditional offer. They should submit, together with their Application Form, a copy of their latest transcript showing their module grades and their CPA.

- ♦ This is a high-calibre, 2-year extended Masters programme in Economics offered by the University of Mauritius in close collaboration with the African Economic Research Consortium (AERC – website: www.aercafrica.org), a public, non-profit making organisation devoted to advanced economic research and training, based in Nairobi, Kenya. Students will spend their first year at the University of Mauritius, where they will take 3 core modules and sit for the examinations (around May 2011). On successful completion of the core modules, students will travel to Nairobi late June 2011 to take 2 elective modules over one semester at the Joint Facility for Electives (JFE), Nairobi. Finally, they will return to the University of Mauritius to prepare their MA thesis during the 4th semester.

All fees relating to the programme are payable to the University of Mauritius. However, the AERC, as per practice, will meet tuition costs for all students at the JFE, Nairobi. In addition, it will take care of the travel and accommodation costs for students not sponsored by their employer.

- **School-Leavers** who are ranked after the 2010 LAUREATES are eligible for Scholarship at the University upon registration as students of the University of Mauritius. The Scholarship covers the General Fees, but excludes Registration Fees and Students' Welfare Fund Fee (amounting to Rs 1,800). The Scholarship must be taken in the current Academic Year and may not be postponed.
 - Tuition fees are exclusive of general fees.
 - **A 5% discount on Tuition Fees will be provided to students paying the whole amount of their Tuition Fees for the academic year upon registration.**
 - **Candidates are strongly advised to consult the website address <http://kdf.intnet.mu> regarding Government Guaranteed Student Loan Scheme and Student Scholarship Scheme under the "Human Resource, Knowledge and Arts Development (HRKAD) Fund.**
 - Please note that the following **Direct Debit facilities (bank standing order)** will be available for settlement of tuition fees only and upon request. If you avail yourself of this facility, you will be required to settle your fees as follows:

- (i) General Fees in full + 50% of Tuition Fees to be paid on registration date
- (ii) Balance of 50% of Tuition Fees to be paid in 3 equal and consecutive monthly instalments. A standing order form will be available at the Budget Director's Office during the registration exercise. The form duly filled in, should be submitted before registration. In case of revocation of the standing order before its termination, you will not be admitted to the examinations as per University regulations.

HOW TO APPLY

- **Application for admission will be open online as from 28 July 2010 and all procedures and instructions indicated should be carefully followed.**
- Candidates who are applying for the first time should send, by registered post, to the Admissions and Student Records Office, Engineering Tower, University of Mauritius, Réduit, a printed and signed Online Application Form as per instructions, together with a Bank Office Cheque or a Postal Money Order (drawn to the order of UNIVERSITY OF MAURITIUS) of Rs 1 000 representing a non-refundable Application Fee. Personal Cheques will not be accepted. Photocopies of educational certificates and other supporting documents should be attached. Applicants will not be required to call at the University for application procedures.
- Applicants are also strongly advised to retain the Mauritius Post Ltd postage receipt and a photocopy of their Bank Office Cheque or Postal Money Order as evidence of their application.
- The University will acknowledge receipt of application online when all the above-mentioned documents are received. Applicants will thereafter be able to print their receipt online.
- Unsuccessful candidates, who had previously applied in the academic year 2010/2011, but have not secured a seat on their initially selected programme(s), may apply for any of the programmes. Such candidates should send, by registered post, to the Admissions and Student Records Office, Engineering Tower, University of Mauritius, Réduit, a printed and signed Online Application Form as per instructions. They will not be required to pay any additional application fee.

Applications should reach the Admissions and Student Records Office, University of Mauritius, Réduit not later than 10 August 2010.

- (v) Documents submitted will not be returned to applicants.
