

Airports of Mauritius Co. Ltd (AML)
Sponsorship Scheme For Needy Students - 2010/ 2011

Applications are invited from 5 deserving and needy students; three (3) students from the Faculty of Engineering and two (2) students from the Faculty of Science who have obtained admission on 1st year full time Undergraduate Degree Programmes of Studies at the University of Mauritius (UoM) for the Academic year 2010/ 2011 and who wish to be considered for Sponsorship by AML.

Eligibility

1. Only students whose parents' income does not exceed *Rs15,000* monthly will be eligible to apply for the Scholarship. Information on the financial situation of the student's family will need to be produced, e.g evidence of monthly income of parents.
2. Students whose parents are recipients of social security benefits.
3. They should not be beneficiaries of any scholarship or grant.
4. Students in unexpected personal difficulties.
5. The Scholarship will include an all-inclusive grant of *Rs100,000* per student per academic year till completion of their Programmes of Studies.

Selection Procedure

1. Selection of beneficiaries of the Scholarships will be carried out by the UoM Needy Students Fund Committee assisted by 2 representatives of AML.
2. The beneficiaries must subscribe to an Agreement to follow and complete the Programme of Studies and to inform the UoM if they obtain another scholarship/grant or decide to withdraw from the Programme of Studies.
3. Renewal of the Scholarships for the 2nd and subsequent years will depend on good academic results for the previous academic year, regular attendance and good behaviour as certified by UoM. A quarterly report will be sought from UoM on the last two aspects.

Application

1. Applications must be made on the prescribed form obtainable from Admissions and Students Record Office, University of Mauritius, Réduit, or can be downloaded on the following UoM website: www.uom.ac.mu

Applicants should submit copies of the following supporting documents along with their application:

- (i) Birth Certificate and National Identity Card;
 - (ii) National Identity Card of Responsible Party/ies;
 - (iii) Evidence of monthly income of parents, marital status of parents and proof of need for financial assistances;
 - (iv) A letter from the Faculty/Centre concerned certifying that the applicant is a registered student of the UoM.
2. Applications along with all supporting documents should be sent by registered post to the Admissions and Students Records Office of the UoM by 03 September 2010.
