Vacation Research Scholarship Scheme for Graduates

Duration: 8-12 weeks

UoM Stipend: Yes

Certificate of Participation: Yes

Credit for the Course: Yes (6 credits for 8 weeks or pro rata – Min 3)

Application Deadline: 31 May 2011

Starting Date: At the end of examinations or upon arrangement

End Date: 1st August of each year

Awarding Date upon satisfactory completion: to be decided

Number of Scholarships available

Five scholarships will be offered annually – one per Faculty.

It is anticipated that there will be stiff competition for this grant.

Eligibility

To be eligible, the student must:

- be an alumni of the University of Mauritius;
- not be an employee of the University;
- obtain the agreed support of a supervisor (who has to be a member of staff) ;
- write a project proposal (typically in collaboration with the nominated supervisor and to submit it to the Office of the Vice-Chancellor by the set deadline);
- submit a brief CV;

Method of Application

Online.

Selection Criteria

Awarded to the highest achieving students based on CPA. Applicants will be matched to projects available. Unsuccessful applicants will be notified (via notice boards) once all offers have been made and accepted by eligible students.

Upon Completion

The student will give a presentation of 20-30 mins.
