

## **Confucius Institute at UoM HSK & HSKK Exams, March 2024**

On Saturday March 16, the Confucius Institute at the University of Mauritius organized the first offline HSK & HSKK exams for the year 2024. A total of 17 candidates participated in six different exams including HSK Level 2, Level 3, Level 4, Level 5, as well as HSKK Intermediate and HSKK Advanced levels, with all candidates completing their respective exams successfully.

The exams were thoroughly prepared by the Confucius Institute and two days prior to the exams, all invigilators attended the training to study the latest examination regulations and to learn to use of recording equipment for the HSKK exams.
