1. Block Fees

The University reserves the right to review General Fees, Tuition Fees and other charges for any given academic year prior to the beginning of such academic year. By accepting a seat at the University, the student undertakes to pay all such fees as and when claimed.

Note:

University of Mauritius Scholarships

International students will be eligible for a scholarship covering 50% of the block fee to be paid to the University subject to meeting the requirements for admission on the programme <u>and</u> subject to one of the following conditions:

- EITHER They should come through an approved University Recruitment Agent;
- OR They should be from Africa mainland, including SADC and COMESA member countries <u>or</u> from Asian Developing Countries (e.g India, Pakistan, Sri Lanka, Bangladesh, Nepal, China and Indonesia)
