



FAQs

When can I apply and how?

Information on programmes to be offered and the application procedures is available on the University website around February/March.

Application for admission will be open online. The duly completed Application Form together with copies of birth and educational certificates and proof of payment of Application Fee of 50 US Dollars, exclusive of bank charges, should be submitted online.

Are the University of Mauritius' awards internationally recognised?

The University of Mauritius awards are recognised internationally.

When does the Academic Year start?

The UoM Academic Year is composed of two Semesters, of 15 Weeks each. Semester One of the Academic Year 2021/2022 starts on 15 November 2021.

What is the medium of instruction?

The medium of instruction is English, but some programmes have a few modules taught in French.

Can I start a programme in its second year?

The University does consider granting exemptions. Full documentary support (such as modules and year of completion, grades achieved, number of contact hours, syllabi) must be provided at the time of application for consideration.

What do I do if I need help finding a place to live in Mauritius? How much does accommodation cost and how much do I need for other living costs?

The University is non-residential. International students are assisted in finding a suitable lodging in the vicinity of the campus. Students would need approximately 500 US \$ monthly for accommodation and living expenses.

Provision for about 200 US \$ per annum should be made for purchase of books etc... You may consult the list of private rented accommodations or consult websites in Mauritius for student accommodation.

Do I need students Entry Visa and how do I obtain my Entry Visa to Mauritius?

For international applicants who have been offered a seat, the University will arrange with the Passport & Immigration Office in Mauritius for the entry visa and residence permit for the duration of their studies.

Evidence of adequate funds to meet the costs of stay and studies will have to be produced.

Does the University offer a full programme by distance education mode?
