## **Government e-Procurement System**

In line with Government's plan towards a fully-fledged digital society requiring increased use of ICT in public administration, public bodies would, by the end of December 2020, carry out public procurement electronically on the Government e-Procurement System (e- PS). To this effect, the Procurement Policy Office has issued Directive No. 47 - **Mandatory Use of the e-Procurement System** dated 21.08.20 which is posted on the following link:

The University has started carrying out its procurement proceedings online. Consequently, the paper based procurement process is being gradually phased out.

To be able to participate online in UoM's bidding exercises on the e-PS, bidders should:

Training will be provided free of charge by the Procurement Policy Office to registered suppliers.
