

## COLLABORATIVE PROVISIONS IN TEACHING AND LEARNING

### 3. PARTNER INSTITUTIONS

- 3.1 All partners with whom the University of Mauritius enters into collaborative provision must become either an **Associate** or **Affiliated Institution** of the University of Mauritius.
- 3.2 Presently, according to the definitions as outlined in the document, the Mauritius Institute of Education (MIE) and Mahatma Gandhi Institute (MGI) may be considered as Associate Institutions and the SSR Medical College, Apollo Bramwell Nursing School (ABNS) and UOM Trust as Affiliated Institutions.
- 3.3 In an Associate Institution, the students are registered as students of the University of Mauritius whereas in an Affiliated Institution, the students are registered as students of the Affiliated Institution.
- 3.4 An institution may be admitted as an Associate or Affiliated Institution of the University of Mauritius for any or all of the following purposes:
- (i) recognition of Programme(s) of Studies taught wholly at the Partner Institution for the purpose of satisfying the University's regulations for the award of specified degrees, diplomas and certificates of the University of Mauritius;
  - (ii) the recognition of periods of study in the Partner Institution for the purpose of providing progression on to a Programme of Studies leading to an award of a specified degree, diploma or certificate of the University of Mauritius.
- 3.5 A Partner Institution should abide by the following minimum conditions:
- (i) it should be established on a permanent basis;
  - (ii) its physical infrastructure and financial position are satisfactory;
  - (iii) its academic standing and available facilities are adequate/appropriate; and
  - (iv) it has adequate resources and has/ can put in place mechanisms needed to ensure the maintenance of the required standards and quality.
