EXTERNAL EXAMINING OF UNDERGRADUATE AND POSTGRADUATE TAUGHT DEGREE PROGRAMMES

9. Termination of Appointment

- 9.1 The appointment of an External Examiner may be terminated by Senate, on the recommendation of the relevant Faculty/Centre Board and Teaching and Research Committee, under the following circumstances:
 - (a) failure to attend Board of Examiners meetings without the prior agreement of the Chairman of the Board;
 - (b) failure to submit the External Examiner's report within the specified time after several reminders;
 - (c) failure to carry out duties identified in the University's document on external examination.
