### FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE AND SCHOLARSHIPS FOR NEEDY STUDENTS AT THE UNIVERSITY OF MAURITIUS

Students who are registered on **full-time non-tuition fee paying undergraduate programmes** at the University of Mauritius and who are facing financial difficulties may avail themselves of the facilities of the various Schemes existing at the University:

1. **The University of Mauritius Students Financial Assistance Fund** grants a one-off financial assistance for the current academic year and students must re-apply each academic year. The call for applications will be around end of July of each year and will be advertised on the UoM website, UoM Social Media Platforms, Students' Union Facebook page and Notice Boards.
2. **The University of Mauritius Scholarship Scheme for Disabled Students (both at undergraduate and postgraduate levels).**
3. **Scholarships and financial assistance offered by other institutions and companies under CSR programmes:**

The Scholarship may be either a one-off or renewable each academic year subject to conditions specified by each Donor.

#### **A few examples are:**

- Scholarships to Children from Vulnerable Families from the Ministry of Education and Human Resources, Tertiary Education and Scientific Research
- Mutual Aid Foundation Scholarships
- Scholarship Scheme of the Sir Jean Etienne Moilin Ah-Chuen Foundation (ABC Group of Companies)
- Standard Bank Mauritius Scholarship Scheme

The Scholarships/Financial assistance will be open to:

- Students who have already secured a seat at the University of Mauritius;
- Students who have already paid the University fees and completed the registration formalities.

The call for applications for scholarships/financial assistance will normally be posted on the homepage of the UoM website [www.uom.ac.mu](http://www.uom.ac.mu) under "**Assistance to Students/Scholarships**", on the UoM Social Media Platforms, Students' Union Facebook page, via email and on Notice Boards across the campus during the academic year.
