Qualifications:

Selection will be made among UoM Graduates in Accounting, Finance, Management, Economics, Statistics or any other related fields and/or Final Year University Students who have completed the Research Methodology Module and awarded at least a Pass grade in this module.

Profile

Candidates must have:

- Research and communication skills;
- Analytical skills and adequate knowledge in the relevant field of Research;
- Experience in data collection both online and on field; and
- Experience in administering online questionnaires.

Responsibilities & Duties

- Collect survey data (as instructed) in accordance with the quota allocated;
- Attend training sessions and meetings; and
- Report to the Investigators of this project on a regular basis.

Stipend

A stipend of MUR175 per questionnaire administered in accordance with the quota allocated.

Duration

The period of involvement as Fieldworkers will be for three (3) months. The proposed starting date is 26 June 2023.
