The Faculty of Information, Communication and Digital Technologies is inviting expressions of interest from qualified individuals to be involved as **Consultant for Data Collection**, for a task-based assignment to work on the research project entitled "Assessing technology readiness among older adults: for the future development of health and well-being programmes", for a contractual period of three (3) months or equivalent working hours.

Qualifications required:

• A degree in Physiotherapy, Health Science, Information and Communication Technology (ICT) or any related degree in the field of the research project.

Profile

Candidates must be:

- able to use a portable device to administer a survey;
- willing to travel to different regions of Mauritius to meet respondents;
- patient and willing to communicate with senior citizens;
- fluent in English, French and Creole;
- able to translate English to Creole or French;
- available to attend research meeting(s); and
- available to commence work starting from <u>January 2024.</u>

Note: Candidates MUST not be involved in other research project where they are conducting data collection while being involved in this project.

Responsibilities & Duties

Data Collection for Survey

- Attend Meeting and training sessions at the University of Mauritius for conducting interventions;
- Administer survey to at least 225 respondents (50 years old or above) from different regions of Mauritius from mixed age groups over the duration of the contract;
- Use a combination of data collection techniques, including questionnaires and interviews with at least 225 respondents;
- Travel to assigned region(s) and administer / provide support in filling survey in appropriate venues, such as Care homes, Community and Social Welfare Centers, respondents' place of residence, etc.;
- Test the survey questionnaire is functional before and after each survey administration;
- Methodically record and transmit gathered data to the research team at the

University of Mauritius;

- Backup survey data files online and offline;
- Conduct basic analytics of the data collected; and
- Participate in debrief and assessment of the gathered data and observations made.

Stipend

An all-inclusive stipend of Rs 66,000/- payable in 3 equal installments of Rs 22,000 upon satisfactory completion for every batch of 75 survey administered.

Duration

The period of involvement as **Consultant for Data Collection** will be for a period equivalent to 3 months, starting in January 2024 and ending in May 2024.
