Applications are invited from suitably qualified candidates for the post of **Research Assistant**, for a task-based assignment to work on the research project entitled “Health and Wellness 2.0: Assessing the impact of an exergaming application for the promotion of healthy behaviours in Mauritius”, for a contractual period of two months.

Candidates who previously applied for this vacancy do not need to re-apply and will also be considered.

Qualifications Required:

- A degree in Computer Science, Software Engineering, Applied Computing, Information Systems or any other equivalent qualification.

Profile

Candidates must have:

- Good IT and programming skills (Specially Web-based; PHP & JavaScript)
- Knowledge of JavaScript UI Frameworks and Libraries will be an advantage
- Analytical skills and adequate knowledge in the relevant field of research
- Proficiency in customising computer applications
- The skills to develop and test applications according to a set of measures
- Good interpersonal skills
- The ability to attend regular meetings, both face-to-face and online during normal office hours
- Experience in the design and development of web-based applications (Experience in web-based exergaming applications will be an advantage)
- Availability to start work from the 11th of September 2023.

Responsibilities & Duties

Task 1

- Review the literature on gamification and health promotion
- Tailor and improve an existing web-based computer application to the specification of the research
- Test the application as appropriate to the specific objectives of the study
- Use cloud-based and web-server services for hosting and operating the web-based applications.
- Maintain accurate records of the development/ programming of the application
- Attend meetings & training concerning the project
- Prepare progress reports

- Any other tasks related to the project

Task 2

- Train a team of Trainee Project Assistants to use the developed application
- Update the application as necessary, to fix bugs or for minor improvements as necessary following the evaluation
- Attend meetings & training concerning the project
- Prepare progress reports
- Any other tasks related to the project
