The Faculty of Social Sciences & Humanities is inviting expressions of interest from qualified individuals to be involved as **Field Workers (Part-Time)** for the research project entitled "*Phonology of Mauritian French and Mauritian Creole*", for a period of 4 months.

Qualifications:

Selection will be made among UoM Graduates and Post-Graduates in French Studies or any other related fields and/or Final Year University Students who have completed the Research Methodology Module and awarded at least a Pass grade in this module.

Profile

Candidates must have:

- Excellent skills in writing French and Creole;
- Research and communication skills;
- Excellent skills in phonological analysis and use of Praat;
- Analytical skills and adequate knowledge in the relevant field of Research;
- Experience in data collection on field; and
- Driving permit would be useful.

Responsibilities & Duties

- Collect data (as instructed) in accordance with the quota allocated;
- Attend training sessions and meetings; and
- Report to the Investigators of this project on a regular basis.

Stipend

A stipend of MUR 1,000 per interview completed in accordance with the quota allocated (50 interviews in total).

Duration

The period of involvement as Fieldworkers will be for 4 months. The proposed starting date is 13th May 2024.
