

## SURVEY FIELD WORKERS (Part-Time)

The University of Delaware in the United States is running a research project on ***“Peer-to-Peer Solar Energy Trading among Mauritian households”*** and is seeking applications for candidates (including university students, 2<sup>nd</sup> year) interested in working as Field workers for the project for a period of 1.5 to 2 months.

### Tasks

Candidates are expected to:

- Collect survey data (as instructed by the Principal Investigator);
- Report to the Principal Investigator on a regular basis

Note that:

- Questionnaires (online and printed) will be provided to candidates who have to survey households (one person per household)
- A short information /training session will be conducted to train candidates on how to administer the survey
- Candidates can either administer the questionnaires online, contact respondents by phone, or be on the field to talk to respondents to seek inputs

### Candidate Profile

Candidates must have:

- Have excellent communication skills;
- Have some general knowledge of solar technologies
- Maintain absolute confidentiality of the survey results
- Respect deadlines
- Experience in administering surveys and data collection (preferred, not mandatory)

### Qualifications

Either a currently enrolled university student in a degree programme in Engineering, Science or any other related field

### Stipend

Candidates will be given a

- A stipend of Rs 180 per questionnaire administered
- An Unlimited Mobile Data Pack (for one month) of Rs 371 for Emtel subscribers and Rs 315 for my.t subscribers

### **Mode of Application and Selection**

A cover letter (maximum 300 words) with a Curriculum Vitae (CV) and scan of certificates and any work experience claimed (in a single pdf) should reach **Mr. Pravesh Raghoo** (Project Coordinator of the Island Policy Lab of the University of Delaware and Principal Investigator) by email at [pravesh@udel.edu](mailto:pravesh@udel.edu) by **February 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2024** by **16.00 hrs**.

Only the highest educational qualification is required. Currently enrolled students can submit a recent transcript (unofficial transcript accepted).

Selection will be made considering the candidates' ability to bring accurate survey responses. Candidates are requested to describe their abilities to survey respondents **highlighting the number of respondents they can survey within the period** of the research project. More than one candidate will be selected.
