Facilities Available to People with Special Needs

Main Campus, Reduit

The following facilities are available on UoM's Main Campus at Reduit for students with special needs:

- (i) Ramps to access all the various buildings on Campus, including the following main ones:
 - Lecture Halls 1 and 2, New Academic Complex (NAC)
 - Faculty of Agriculture Buildings
 - Tower Block Building (NAC) housing the Faculties of Science an Law & Management
 - Prof. Sir Edward Lim Fat Engineering Tower
 - Faculty of Engineering Buildings
 - Library
 - Main Cafeteria and Mini Canteen
 - First Aid Post
 - UoM Gymnasium
 - Paul Octave Wiehe Auditorium (including ramps up to the rostrum for graduation)
- (ii) Lifts are available at the Tower Block (NAC) and at Prof. Sir Edward Lim Fat Engineering Tower.
- (iii) One reserved parking under the Link Bridge near Lecture Theatre 1 (NAC)




Library Services

Provision is made for the seating of students with special needs at the Ground Floor of the UoM Library. Arrangements are in place for Library Staff

to bring whatever material they need to the study carrels on this floor.

Furthermore, they can also have access to the e-library resources from either dedicated facilities at the ground floor or even from any location (in or off Campus). Kindly note that the UoM has also extended its WIFI access to the optimum 98% outdoor coverage of the Campus.



In addition, the Library has an Inclusive Learning Centre for students with visual impairments.
