# FRAMEWORK FOR "CO-TUTELLE" PROGRAMME

## 1. Rationale:

- To foster research collaboration with overseas institutions and encourage networking.
- To share facilities and sophisticated research equipment.
- To facilitate professional mobility.

#### 2. Principle:

- Joint supervision of MPhil/PhD between two University/Research Institutions (A & B).
- Candidate is awarded a degree in MPhil or PhD from both institutions.
- Two Certificates will be issued separately, one by each institution. Each certificate will state that the student has been admitted to the relevant degree under the "Convention de Co-tutelle Universitaire" with the "name" of the Francophone University/Institution. This provision is expected to be reciprocal.

### 3. Requirements:

- General institutional agreement (MoU) to develop a collaborative research programme.
- Separate agreement for each candidature signed by responsible officers of both institutions, preferably at the outset of submission of application for MPhil/PhD.
  The agreement shall comply with rules and regulations for MPhil/PhD program at the home institution with regards to:
  - mechanism for approval of MPhil/PhD proposal
  - o supervisory arrangements;
  - candidature arrangements including enrolment requirements, insurance coverage fees, research costs, apportionment of research time at each institution; candidature withdrawal;
  - o IPR arrangements and conditions;
  - o examination process and appointment of external examiners.

## 4. Conditions:

- Candidature: as per rules and regulations of 'home' institution. Home institution is the institution to which the student submits the research proposal.
- Fee liability: candidate will pay tuition fee of the 'home' institution only. Fees to be waived for overseas students coming to 'home' institution.
- Apportionment of research time: Candidate will have to normally spend a minimum of 30% of research time at each institution.
- Supervision: according to established guidelines 'Roles and responsibilities of Supervisor/s.
- Thesis: to be written in the language of instruction of 'home' institution accompanied by a summary in the language of the other institution if different from 'home' institution.
- Examinations: as per rules and regulations of the 'home' institution.
- 5. The institutions will register the student only after obtaining a "no objection" from each other
